### **DRIVER'S CLASS**

\* A "Class 1" driver who obtains a "B" endorsement for the first time does not have to be re-certified before the end of his/her 4 years certification. If he/she wants to maintain the "B" endorsement then he/she will have to be re-certified every two years thereafter.

### PRE-TRIP INSPECTION

A pre-trip inspection is required for all <u>school</u> <u>vehicles</u>. The content and the type of inspection are established under Policy 504-School Vehicle Inspections and maintenance of school vehicles.

### **EMERGENCY EVACUATION**

EMERGENCY EVACUATION EXERCISE is mandatory for all students. Students that are conveyed in a contracted school vehicle must also be informed of the procedure to exit the vehicle in case of an emergency.

#### **LETTER OF AGREEMENT**

A Letter of Agreement is an agreement with a parents/guardian in lieu of transportation. Specific pupil transportation standards are not required other than the standards established under the Motor Vehicle Act for drivers of a motor vehicle.

A NB Motor Vehicle Inspection (MVI) is required every six (6) months on a school bus and a school vehicle that is a bus (10 or more passengers).
